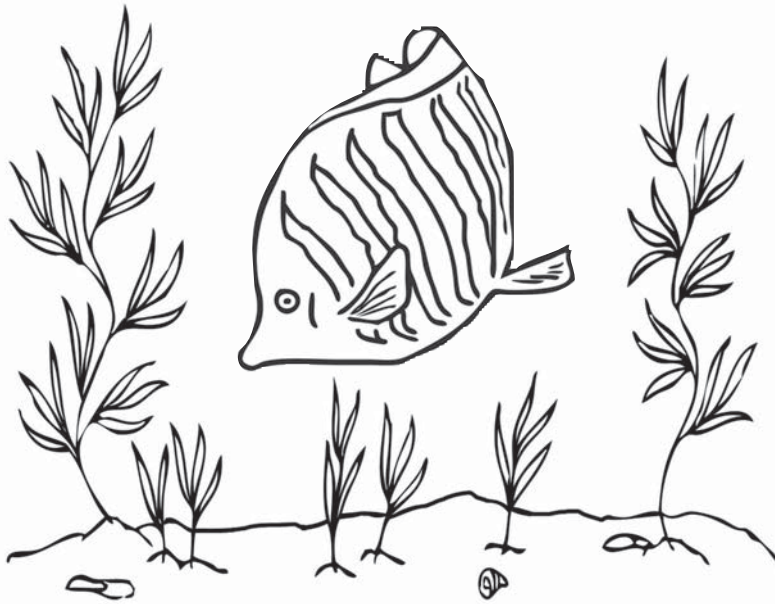


### Meet the Angelfish



The angelfish has a flat, round body. Its body has stripes or spots in bright colors.

The angelfish looks for food in the day. Some angelfish eat crabs and sponges. Others eat plants. At night, the angelfish hides from the bigger fish and eels that hunt it.

The butterflyfish has a thin, round body with bright colors. Some butterflyfish have a long snout. Many have a spot on the tail that looks like an eye.

The butterflyfish eats coral. It pokes its snout into the reef to pull out the little animals. At night, the butterflyfish's bright colors fade to help it hide from eels and sharks.
